





PC Games should run fine if you are using windows on your Mac. We'll suggest you to buy those Macs which either have Intel Iris Pro Graphics or NVIDIA or AMD's graphics. Macs aren't considered to be gaming computers though.

#### Will I be able to run Microsoft Office Files on my Mac?

Yes. You can open Microsoft Office files on OSX, using the pre-installed iWork Productivity suite or you can also get a copy of Office for Mac to best view those files.

#### Is Adobe's Creative Suite Available for OSX?

Yes. Adobe's entire range of products is available for OSX and is being actively updated.

#### If I get a DVD SuperDrive, will I be able to play Movie DVDs Natively?

Even though Appple's latest Macs don't include SuperDrives, you still get the DVD Player Software that allows you to play DVDs from Remotely Shared Disks or External SuperDrives. VLC is also available for OSX.

I heard that Apple's releasing a new version of OSX this autumn. Will I need to pay for the update? No. OSX Yosemite will be available as a free update.

#### What are the warranty details for a Mac?

You get 90 Days free telephone support and a one-year global warranty. You can also get an extened warranty for your Mac with an AppleCare Protection Plan (which you can buy seperately).

#### Is it true that Macs aren't prone to any type of viruses or malware?

You don't need to install any type of anti viruses for your OSX Device as the risk of a virus is next to zero and it hardly ever gets affected. However, nothing is 100% free from security threats, you can contact any Apple Store for assistance if you feel that something's wrong with your Mac.

#### How can I track my lost Mac?

You can also make use of the Find my Mac feature to successfully track your Mac if its lost.
